Cut-off dates: 1st Policy cut-off Feb 7th (except fiscal & Transportation committees); 1st fiscal committee cut-off Feb 11th; House of Origin Feb 19th; 2nd Policy cut-off Feb 28th; 2nd fiscal committee cut-off March 2nd; Opposite House March 6th (except initiatives and alternatives to initiatives, budgets and matters necessary to implement budgets, differences between the houses, and matters incident to the interim and closing of the session). March 12th is the last day of session.
