**December/January**

**February/March**

Create accountability

**April/May**

Reorganizing of the current SAIL Roberts Rules of Order and define what harassment means and what type of complaints require staff to be involved when members have issues with other members. Look at options for structuring decision making for the whole group

**June/July**

We will investigate the pros and cons of staying a membership organization, operating on our own as a stand alone or becoming a 501c3 or 501c4 in 2025
