### **Asset and Retirement Limits**

The ability to build wealth is essential to equal participation in society and security as one ages. SAIL believes caps to assets and retirement should be raised by the Social Security Administration.



### **Marriage Penalty**

The Social Security Marriage Penalty often forces people with IDD to choose between their intimate relationships and the ability to survive and thrive independently. SAIL supports eliminating this penalty.



### **Home and Community-Based Services**

The Home and Community Based Services Act allows people with IDD to live in the community. SAIL believes people with IDD should be the primary stakeholders in developing the updates to this act.



### **Employment**

SAIL supports federal initiatives to increase employment options for people with IDD to obtain and keep gainful employment in community settings.



### **Americans with Disabilities Act**

The DD Act is the most significant public action to secure the rights of people with disabilities in the last half century. SAIL believes people with IDD are critical stakeholders and should actively participate as the Act is updated.

### **DD Act**



SAIL believes when the DD Act is reauthorized a new DD Network Partner focused on self-advocacy/civil rights run by people with IDD should be equally included, supported and funded.
