Guest Speaker from Northwest Center: Amy Doran, Shannon Ramsay, and Ashley Stevens from Northwest Center came to speak about the services offered to individuals and how to get involved if anyone was interested. Services provided are: Early Learning and Intervention, Job Placement, School to Work, Job Coaching, Community Based Assessments, Retention, and Community Inclusion.

Amber Leaders Meeting Update: We haven't met yet, there is a meeting this Thursday.

Community Summit Update: The next Community Summit will be June 18th, 19th and 20th. It is going to be a later date this coming year so that kids will be out of school so more people and teachers will be

able to participate. Feedback from the Community Summit was about timing. People missed parts of the summit due to the self advocate part of the event being held too early.

Allies in Advocacy: Allies has decided that their future priorities are to support Nothing About US Without US. All priorities will be decided on at the next board meeting. The next public meeting will be on October 6th from 1-3.

There are 2 or 3 consultants who are going to be helping SAIL to make position statements and goals in order to become a 501C3. These consultants will attend a few SAIL meetings.

Nothing About US Without US: We had a great panel over the weekend. It went very well. We are still getting people involved to learn about the bill. The plan is to get it back on the house floor to get it to the Senate. We just need to get the policy part through.
